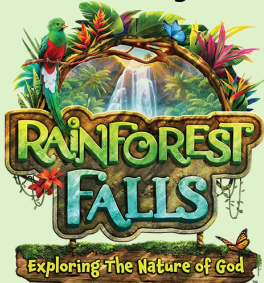
## VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL

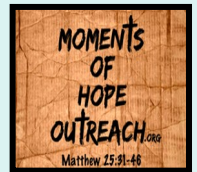

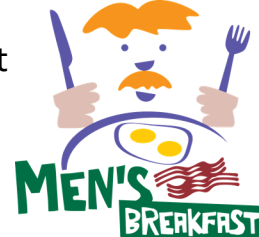
### SATURDAY SERVINGS
